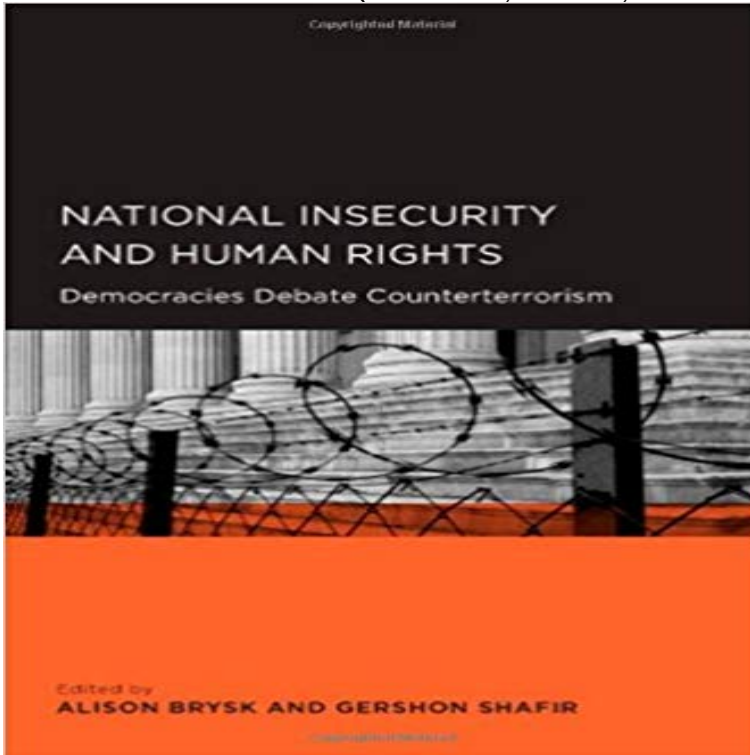


National Insecurity and Human Rights: Democracies Debate Counterterrorism (Global, Area, and International Archive)
