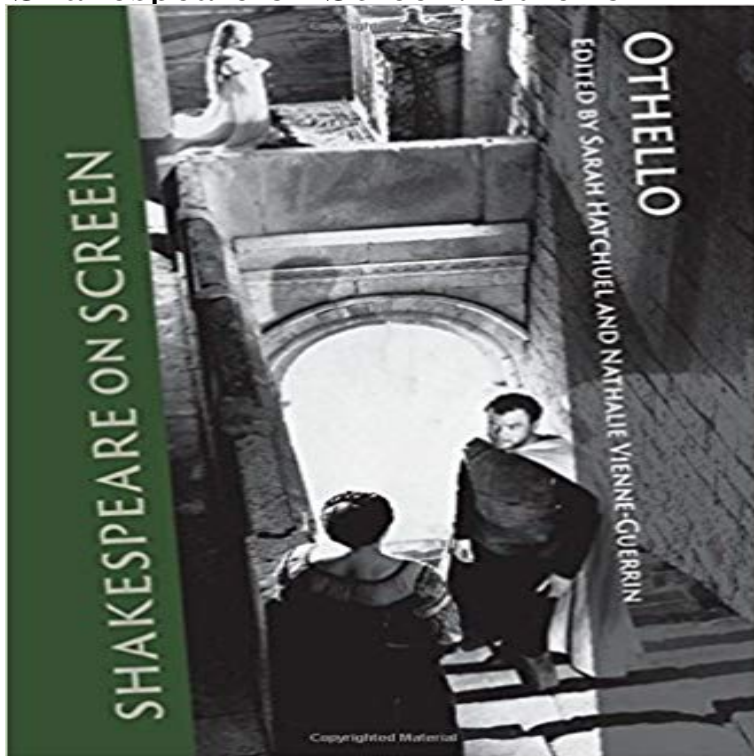


Shakespeare on Screen: Othello
